- ✓ Please read chapter 13 (pg. 479-505) in your *Bedford Introduction to Literature* text. This chapter focuses entirely on William Faulkner's "Barn Burning."
  - ✓ Read the story.
- ✓ Answer the following questions under "Considerations for Critical Thinking and Writing" 1,2,3,4,6,7,12. (Beginning on page 494)

Responses to each question need to be typed, MLA format; use textual evidence to support your statements. Number each question/response.

- ✓ Read each of the four perspectives beginning on page 495: "Blood Ties in 'Barn Burning'" by Jane Hiles; "Abner Snopes as a Victim of Class" by Benjamin DeMott; "Conflict in 'Barn Burning'" by Gayle Edward Wilson; and "Narrative Strategy in 'Barn Burning'" by James Ferguson.
- ✓ Then answer questions 3 and 5 from page 504 "Incorporating the Critics."
  - For question 3, be sure to summarize each critic's argument in a separate paragraph.
     Identify the nature and purpose of the critic's argument. Identify passages in the critic's piece that were especially helpful to you. That is, in responding to this question, you will not be supplying simple "yes and no" response.
  - In responding to question 5, your typed (MLA format) explanation should be about two
    pages long and include adequate textual support/examples to fully articulate your
    understanding of the story.
